L.C.O.A. Compliance**

This letter certifies that L.C.O.A. does not add any of the named substances to the L.C.O.A. products that it manufactures. Furthermore, L.C.O.A. has letters on file from its raw material suppliers certifying their compliance as well.

Trace amounts of the heavy metals named in the list may be present in the paper fibers due to natural incorporation of minerals from forest soils during normal tree growth, but the suppliers have certified that the paper is in compliance with the CONEG requirement that the sum of the concentrations of lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent, is less than 100ppm.
